Xof1 Mobile Weather Sensors.

Xof1 received equipment from Campbell Science Ltd Alaska, to put a mobile weather station (Pyraometer & Annemometer ) on the project support vehicle along with other equipment for Vehicle sensing & support. Supporters in Vancouver helped get the sensors mounted during Xof1's last stop over in Vancouver in late October. With 10 years experience in design, setup & programming of CSI dataloggers & telemetry, I ([www.tqelx.com](http://www.tqelx.com)) managed to get the electronics installed, wired & programmed in the support Van in about 6 hours.

Weather Sensor Data will help document the availability of Sunlight, along with other conditions affecting vehicle travel such as Wind while the Xof1 & Marcello continue their Solar Powered Travels.

PS. For eFarm curious...

No, Marcello did not take any electric Fuel from TQELX's Solar energy farm in front of it's shop, but it was offered to him. Marcello said, It would have been his first import of renewable or any other electricity into the Xof1 on his trip so far . We were ready to provide the vehicle with a 108Vdc 2Amp DC service if he wanted it.. Clearly this is a car & man are driven to run with what the have as they go... including fuel.
